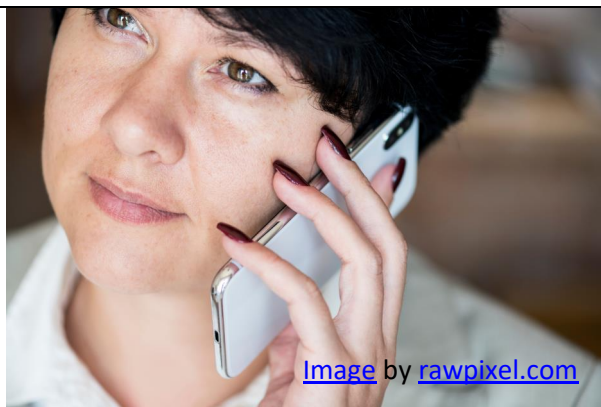

## When I visit the library

This is the library entrance. The door is automatic and will open as I approach it.

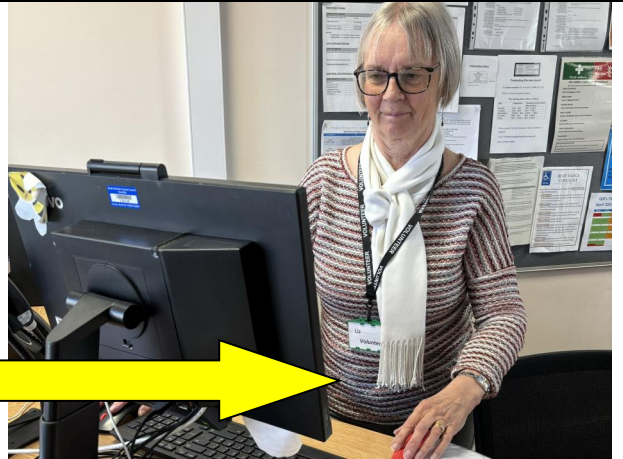


When I enter the library I will see a desk.



There are people who work at the library who I can talk to.

I will know who they are because they will be wearing a lanyard.



I can talk to someone who works there to become a member of the library.

I will tell them my name, address, date of birth, telephone number and email address.



If I prefer, I can write my details on a form and give the form to a staff member.



I will be given a library card which I can use to borrow books.



In the library there will be shelves of books, audiobooks and DVDs.



The library is usually quiet.

Sometimes it might be noisier.

It might be noisier at these times:

I can sit in a chair to read a book, magazine or newspaper.



I can get a drink from the hot drink machine.

I pay for my drink at the desk.



There is a public, accessible toilet in the back corner of the library, opposite the entrance door.

I can find it to the right of the wall clock.



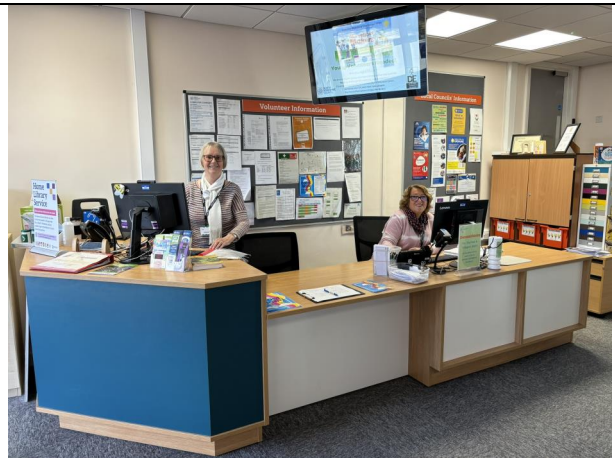
I can borrow books, audiobooks and jigsaws and take them home with me.

I can borrow up to 10 books for free.

I will have to pay to borrow an audiobook.



If I want to borrow a book I will talk to a member of the library staff.



The staff member will show me how to borrow books, audiobooks or jigsaws and tell me when I need to bring them back to the library.



The library will also have some computers.

To use the computers I can reserve a time slot with a member of staff or wait for one to be available.



The computers are free to use for one hour.

If I want to use the computer for longer, I can pay for extra time.



When I am ready to leave I can exit the library through the automatic doors.
